Winter Reflections

The next LTCS concert will be December 5th and 6th, 2009. The Choral Society will perform under the direction of Dr. Tim Hendrickson, accompanied by Howard Richards.

The theme of the concert is *Winter Reflections*. The Choral Society will perform *The Glory of the Father: The Word was Made Flesh* by Norwegian composer Egil Hovland, *Velvet Shoes* by Michael Larkin and *In the Bleak Midwinter* written by Harold Darke based on a poem by Christina Rossetti. Other pieces will be the classic Christmas selections *Ave Maria* by Franz Biebl, *Wassail*, *Wonderful Peace* by Gustaf Nordqvist, and *The Holly and the Ivy* arranged by John Rutter.

The choir will also sing favorite spirituals *Music Down in My Soul* by Moses Hogan, *The Word Was God* by Rosephayne Powell, John Rutter's *Go Tell it on the Mountain*, and Wendel Werner's *This Boat*.

The highlight of the concert will be the world premiere of a very special piece. In 2008 the LTCS commissioned Wendel Werner, a nationally known pianist and composer, to compose selections for the LTCS based on the marquetry panels by wood artist Ed Lantzer. Each marquetry panel illustrates a Biblical scene. Mr. Werner has named the work *My Father's Love*. The Choral Society will perform the first title of this work: *My Father's Love: Birth*.

The concerts will be Saturday December 5, 2009 at 7:30 pm at the First Presbyterian Church in Harbor Springs and Sunday December 6, 2009 at 3:00 pm at the Cross in the Woods Catholic Shrine in Indian River.

Tickets will be available on November 10, 2009 at the Petoskey Chamber of Commerce and from LTCS members. Advance sale tickets are \$ 10 Adults, \$5 students and children 12 and over. Tickets at the door are \$12 Adults, \$6 students and children 12 and over.
